



SALEM ELECTORAL BOARD MINUTES

NOVEMBER 8-14, 2023

The meeting of the City of Salem Electoral Board was held Wednesday, November 8, 2023, beginning at 11:05am. Notice of the meeting was posted in accordance with Section 2.2-3707 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended.

All of the members of the Board were present in person. Mr. Zachary Agee (Chair), Ms. Elizabeth Bowles (Vice Chair), and Ms. Katherin Elam (Secretary). Also, in attendance Salem City's Director of Elections, Dana Oliver.

The sole purpose of the meeting was to canvass the results of the state senate and congressional race of November 7, 2023.

Provisional ballots and same day registration ballots were reviewed first in precinct order 1-10. There were 32 provisional ballots recorded and there were seven ballots set aside. The board then reviewed the number of votes called in the night before from each precinct. The board adjourned at 1pm to reconvene Monday, November 14.

The Salem Electoral Board met at 9 am Monday, November 14 the second day of canvass to review any ballots postmarked November 7 that may have arrived in the registrar's office late. There were seventeen late ballots that were included in the total number of votes listed below.

The votes were confirmed as follows:

House of Delegates: Joseph Mc Namara - 4492 votes cast

Misty Dawn Vickers - 2423 votes cast

Virginia Senate: David Suetterlein - 4405 votes cast

Trish White-Boyd - 2540 votes cast


